OUR EXPECTATIONS

- <u>Prohibited Items</u>: No pets, amplified sound, power generators, or grills are allowed.
- Environment: Help protect the park's grounds by not staking anything into the ground.
- Safety: Be mindful of your surroundings and help ensure the safety of all Festival patrons.
- <u>Booth Conduct</u>: Stay within your booth space. Wandering, canvassing, or distributing materials outside your booth is not allowed.
- <u>Space Use</u>: Vendors may not share or sublet their space without written permission from Atlanta Pride's executive director (or designee).
- <u>Donations</u>: Only authorized vendors may solicit donations within their booth area.
- <u>Beverage Sales</u>: Only authorized vendors may distribute beverages.
- <u>Content Guidelines</u>: This is a family-friendly event. Any adult content must be displayed according to local, state, and federal laws. Atlanta Pride is not responsible for booth closures by law enforcement due to non-compliance, and no refunds will be issued.
- <u>Vendor Responsibilities</u>:
 - Ensure you have all necessary taxes and permits (excluding the Festival permit).
 - Manage and cover costs related to your employees and volunteers.
 - o Comply with all local, state, and federal laws and ordinances.
 - Meet requirements for applicable insurance coverage.
